## **Spring Semester 2022 Program Guide**

As a decision made by Recovery from COVID-19 Committee, we will take steps as such for Spring Semester 2022:

### **Lectures:**

- Those courses with a capacity of fewer than 40 students are conducted in-person format.

- Those courses with a capacity of 40 or more students are conducted remotely.

\*Information on whether a course is conducted in-person or remotely will be available on the course syllabus at course registration.

- Students should return to campus if they have at least one in-person course.

- Remote learning will be conducted online via platforms such as Zoom. Class time is the same as stated in the syllabus.

- Seat arrangement complies with Government disinfection guidelines in classrooms.

### **Exams:**

- Exams are conducted in-person for in-person courses.

- Exams are conducted remotely for remote courses.

Sogang University complies with Government Social Distancing Protocol. Whether a program is conducted remotely or in person may be changed during the semester based on public health conditions to reduce the risk and spread of COVID-19.
